October in the Garden

Feed with a supplemental liquid fertilizer*****Remove spent blooms****Spray with fungicide for prevention of mildew****Water slowly to a depth of 2 feet****allow soil to dry out between waterings. *****Remove side buds to encourage larger blooms for fall. (from the U of A Co-op Ext.)
